Background:

ICMR-Centre for Cancer Pathology, ICMR-CCP (Formerly ICMR-NIP) has an active residency training programme for the Diplomate of National Board (DNB) in Pathology since 1994. The Institute has been recognized by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS), an autonomous body under the aegis of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare for training of students in the discipline of Pathology. So far, approximately 70 trainees have completed their training from the Institute with an excellent pass percentage.

Total seat intake per year: Four (4)

Post MBBS:-2/Year

Post Diploma (Pathology):- 2/Year

Duration of training:

3 years for post MBBS students and 2 years for candidates having post-graduate diploma in Pathology.

Training:

As per NBE requirements, comprehensive training is provided to the students with emphasis on hands-on experience in all disciplines of Pathology. The training curriculum and rotation in various departments is based on the NBEMS guidelines as follows:

The faculty members in Pathology have a wide experience of under graduate and post graduate teaching as well as research. Thesis guides of the candidates provide teaching and mentoring support during the training period.

ICMR-CCP is a recognised centre for internal & external Formative assessment examinations. Regular Internal and Formative Assessments are undertaken as per NBEMS rules to assess medical knowledge, procedural & academic skills, interpersonal skills, professionalism, self- directed learning and ability to practice in the system. It is also a NBMS nominated centre for Final practical examinations for Pathology.

Research opportunities:

Students have a unique exposure of research methodology & research methods in the medical sciences & are encouraged to be involved in a Capstone project by their respective guides, though not mandatory this project provides excellent objective research acumen to the DNB trainees, through wet lab work techniques, experimentation & also publication of original research works.

In order to impart a strong base in the field of Pathology, the trainees are also encouraged to participate in regional and national level seminars/workshops/conferences in subjects of interest in general and pathology in particular. Students are encouraged to **present paper & posters at National & international conferences** with opportunities for Travel grant sponsored by DBT, DST & ICMR

Stipend:

Stipend of the candidate during the training period is fixed as per NBEMS guidelines and is displayed on official MCC and NBEMS websites.
